Getting to KettleStone Luxury Villa

IMPORTANT: NO DOMESTIC FLIGHTS ARE ALLOWED AFTER SUNSET BY BAHAMIAN LAW

KettleStone Villa is an oceanfront home located on the outskirts of Fresh Creek, Andros Island, which is 27 nautical miles from Nassau, New Providence Island, Bahamas and only 175 nautical miles from Fort Lauderdale, Florida.

Specifically, we are located 4 miles from the "Fresh Creek" airport (ASD) (MYAF). This is an international airport and a port of entry into the Bahamas so direct flights are permitted.

Typically, the two most common ways to reach KettleStone Villa are:

- 1) Plan your international flight into Nassau airport and then take a short island hopper flight to Fresh Creek using daily scheduled flights or by private charter.
- 2) Fly directly from Fort Lauderdale, FL to Fresh Creek

Ok...We are in Nassau...Now What?

Upon arrival in Nassau, be sure to take the 2 immigration lanes at the far left of the immigration hall listed for 'family islands' – this will speed up your connection greatly as the lines are usually quite long for visitors staying in Nassau. These lanes expedite the process for the purpose of connecting flights to the out islands.

Once you clear immigration and gather your luggage you must head downstairs to clear customs. Once cleared you will find yourself close to the taxi exit and above the door to the right there will be a sign for the Domestic Terminal.

If flying on Azure Air Charters, you then exit the arrivals area where you will see taxis marshals and taxis which you will take to the General Aviation Center. All charter flights depart from the General Aviation Center.

If flying on LeAir then you turn right and walk about 3 minutes until you see the entrance to the Domestic Terminal which you then enter. Once inside the domestic terminal, you walk straight ahead and the LeAir check-in counter will be on the right. Present your booking receipt or itinerary with I.D. and you will be checked in for your flight to **Fresh Creek, Andros Island**.

Nassau to Fresh Creek

<u>LeAir Flight Service</u> departs from Nassau to Fresh Creek from the main domestic flight terminal at 6:45 am and 3 pm daily. Check-in no later than 6:30 am and 2:30 pm respectively, which means your arrival to Nassau should be no later than 1:00 pm to ensure you have sufficient time to clear customs and immigration and reach your check-in location.

<u>Azure Air Charters</u> offers convenient departures from Nassau to Fresh Creek, providing flexibility based on your chosen charter time. Departures take place from the General Aviation Center (GAC), conveniently located on the airport grounds. The GAC is just a brief 5-minute cab ride away, ensuring a hassle-free transition from your arrival to the departure point.

To facilitate a seamless experience for KettleStone guests, Azure Air Charters only requires a check-in time of 10 minutes prior to the flight. This courtesy ensures that you have minimal transition time before embarking on your journey to Andros.

Makers Air is a private flight service that offers both seat fare as well as charter fare. They have regular flight days but also coordinate flights based on demand.

To see if they are a viable option for your travel dates, just give them a call, tell them what you want, and they most likely will make it happen.

Their current fare per seat is posted on their website. Charter prices need to be determined once they have all your information.

The benefit of Maker's Air is that they fly directly into Fresh Creek Airport as well as depart from here.

Depending on your USA domestic flight costs to Fort Lauderdale vs. Nassau this may prove to be a convenient option.

Charter Flight Information

KettleStone Villa has arranged the following charter options and rates should you wish to book a charter more closely matched to your international arrival and more particularly your international departure times given the early departure of the scheduled flights.

This is a local charter service and as such does not have an online presence, but we are happy to arrange this on your behalf.

The current pricing for the charter options is a 5-seat plane round trip for \$1,200.00 or a 9 seat plane round trip plane for \$2,200.00 and you can choose your flight times to match your international schedules.

ALL PRICES ARE SUBJECT TO CHANGE AND OUTSIDE THE CONTROL OF KETTLESTONE VILLA.

Charter Flight Procedure:

Here's the flight information and procedure upon your arrival in Nassau:

Your charter flight to Andros is scheduled with ample time for you to clear customs and immigration and catch the charter. If there are any delays, there's no need to stress as the charter plane owners are accommodating and will wait. In case of excessive delays, simply give me a call.

Upon arrival in Andros, you would have already cleared Customs and Immigration, so no further procedures are required.

Just take a quick 5-minute taxi ride to KettleStone. Taxis are readily available.

Azure Air Charters:

Your private charter departs from the GAC (General Aviation Center), a small domestic flight terminal building located on the airport grounds.

After collecting your baggage and clearing customs, follow the signs for ground transportation/taxi. If you need assistance, there are taxi marshals available. Take a short taxi ride to the GAC, which should cost approximately \$15-\$20. It's advisable to have some change handy. Confirm the price with the taxi driver.

At the GAC, you'll notice it's a relaxed flight building used by locals traveling between the small islands. There are no formal procedures here. Simply inform anyone that you're traveling with Azure (owner "Cardy") and they will assist you. There's a counter before leaving the building where GAC staff can also provide you with assistance.

Please note that aside from restrooms, there are no other facilities at the GAC. If you wish to grab a bite or a drink before your onward travel, head to the Domestic Departure section in the main terminal before taking a taxi over.

Azure Air Charters specializes in private charters specifically for Andros, as in your case. If you experience any delays or arrive earlier than expected, we closely coordinate with the owner "Cardy" and can plan for adjusted times when necessary. Just give me a call on +1 242-357-2746.

Payment for the charter flights is arranged on your behalf, and you'll settle this fare with KettleStone upon your departure.

BOOKING INFORMATION

Note: KettleStone Villa can make all your fishing reservations including providing the necessary deposits to the guides on your behalf.

DEPOSIT

In all cases a pre-booked fishing date requires a \$100 deposit to be made at the time of booking. Should you cancel your reservation >30 days in advance this deposit will be refunded otherwise it is forfeited to the guides. Should you re-schedule your dates >30 days in advance this deposit shall be applied to the new dates. (subject to availability) Should you re-schedule your dates <30 days in advance, your deposit will be forfeited and is not transferable to the new date.

*If the deposit was paid on your behalf by KettleStone Villa, this amount will be added to your bill and is due upon check-out. KettleStone Villa will not bear the cost of deposit for disputed cancellations or re-scheduling. As guides are a third party...we do not arbitrate.

GEAR:

Guests are encouraged to bring their own gear. In the event the guides must provide gear, the gear is to be inspected prior to use and once deemed acceptable is the responsibility of the guest. If you break it...you buy it. The guide will inform KettleStone Villa the cost and this amount will be charged to your KettleStone bill if not paid directly to the guide. Be aware that the Bahamas has imposed duties, fees and VAT on imported goods which affect landed cost. The gear provided by guests can be expensive. Rods and reels can run anywhere from a few hundred dollars for spin rods/reels to thousands of dollars for electric rods/reels. If in doubt, ask before using.

GUIDES:

Our guides are known to KettleStone Villa and selected for their consistent excellent service and expertise.

PERMITS: KettleStone Villa will acquire the appropriate required permits on your behalf and submit the fees with the check-out bill.

DESCRIPTION OF FISHING TYPES

BONEFISHING:

Shallow water sight fishing. Typically fly fishing... but can be spin cast by request. Typically, one or two people plus a guide. Exceptions can be made for three people at an additional charge of \$50.00 but the added weight may prevent the guide from reaching optimal shallow water locations. The boat is a flats boat designed for shallow drafting.

REEF or BOTTOM:

This is bait fishing over a reef and in waters 10 ft to 100 ft deep. Fish are smaller than offshore fish. Examples are Snappers, Yellowtails, Barracuda, Triggerfish, Hinds, Grunts, Porgies and occasionally Groupers. This is usually in a stationary and anchored location.

DEEP DROP:

This is deep- water fishing in depths greater than 300 ft and requires special multi-hook rigging, electric reels and heavy drop weights. The fish caught here are often caught in totally dark waters with very cold temperatures. These fish tend to be larger and dissimilar to reef fish. Red Snapper, Mutton fish and Groupers are typical species caught. The boat is maintained in a stationary position using the constant running of the engine and is fuel intensive.

DEEP SEA:

This is a kind of fishing that requires a trip out into the ocean. The water depth should be at least 100 ft to be considered a deep-sea fishing area. If traveling by boat tends to make you a little queasy, then plan and be prepared to bring the proper medication. This fishing technique is typically referred to as sport or offshore fishing or big game fishing. We are talking about big game fish like Tuna, Shark, Mahi-Mahi, Mackerel, billfish etc. This is very fuel intensive to reach the ocean waters and to troll.

FACTORS AFFECTING PRICING

The size of the vessel, the gear required, the guide's efforts and the amount of fuel required all affect the price.

Bone-fishing requires the smallest boat but often moderate to long run times to get to prime locations and poling by the guides.

Reef fishing requires a slightly larger boat but because it is stationary fishing tends to be more fuel friendly but bait intensive.

<u>Deep Drop Fishing</u> (1-3 mi offshore) requires a bigger boat, electric reels, multiple baits, heavy drop weights and experienced captains to maintain the same location through running motors. This is fuel intensive.

<u>Deep Sea Fishing</u> (1-12 miles offshore) requires the bigger 25'+ boats, heavy gauge gear and line, multiple bait, and experienced captains. This is the most fuel intensive of all fishing styles.

EAST SIDE BONE-FISHING PRICES

2 persons / 4 hrs. / \$400 2 persons / 8 hrs. / \$500

Typically, this is for 2 persons plus guide but a 3rd person is possible for an additional \$50 but be aware some prime shallow locations may be inaccessible given the additional weight.

WEST SIDE BONE-FISHING PRICES

2 persons / 8 hrs. / \$600

Typically, this is for 2 persons plus guide but a 3rd person is possible for an additional \$75 but be aware some prime shallow locations may be inaccessible given the additional weight.

REEF OR CREEK FISHING

(4 persons / 4 hrs. / \$350) (4 persons / 8 hrs. / \$550) \$50 each additional person to a maximum of 6 in total

LOBSTER, SPEAR AND CONCH DIVING

(4 persons / 4 hrs. / \$350) (4 persons / 8 hrs. / \$500) \$50 each additional person to a maximum of 6 in total

If not experienced in free-diving or spear fishing it is recommended that you request a skilled diver to join you.

This usually costs \$75 / 4 hrs.

Whole day fishing requires you to bring a cooler with your water, lunches, and the guide's lunch. This can be arranged for you by KettleStone for \$10 PER PERSON (Minimum \$40). You need to provide your alcoholic beverages in addition to this amount.

Note* When spearfishing, only 2 people in addition to the guide are allowed to be in the water at any given time for safety reasons.

DEEP SEA AND DEEP DROP FISHING

^{*}Whole day fishing requires you to bring a cooler with your water, lunches, and the guide's lunch. This can be arranged for you by KettleStone for \$10 PER PERSON (Minimum \$40). You need to provide your alcoholic beverages in addition to this amount.

All prices listed are <u>exclusive</u> of fuel and oil which will be provided at local market price by the charter owner only to ensure quality grades are always used." Typical fuel consumption is 3-5 GPH Local fuel prices are \$7-\$8 per gallon on average.

*Our Boston Whaler Montauk 170 is a 2019 model with full fishing and sun lounge outfitting. The captain must be a licensed captain, have recent captain experience or currently a boat owner of similar size and type or larger otherwise a Bahamian captain must be hired per insurance requirements.

Bahamian Captain Fees

The current captain's fees range between \$20/hr. and \$25/hr. according to which captain is available. A minimum of 4 hours per day is required to book.

Snorkeling and Scuba Diving

Reef Snorkeling:

\$300 /4 hours/4 persons (\$50 each additional person to a maximum of 6 in total)

Scuba Diving:

*Small Hope Bay Lodge is a diving resort and the only diving operation available. They are not a dive center which means their main priority is to their guests. KettleStone has been given permission for our guests to book subject to the availability of boats and staff. You are required to call the night before to indicate you wish to dive and you will be advised in the following morning as to what the dive will be and whether you can be accommodated.

OPTIONAL FOOD SERVICES WHILE AT KETTLESTONE VILLA

One common concern that a guest often has when staying at a private villa is the availability of food options. Unlike hotels or resorts, private villas do not have on-site restaurants for ordering meals. However, at KettleStone Villa, we understand that meal planning on a quiet island can be worrisome.

To alleviate this concern, we provide complimentary concierge services dedicated to arranging your provisions and fulfilling your meal requirements. We may have fewer staff compared to hotels or resorts, but we prioritize ensuring that your vacation starts with solutions rather than stress. Our concierge team will assist you in making necessary arrangements, ensuring that you have a seamless and enjoyable dining experience during your stay.

WHERE TO BEGIN?

Pre-Arrival

- 1. If having a cook or a chef is an important requirement for your vacation, please let us know as far in advance as possible to ensure these services are available for your chosen times.
- 2. Take a moment to explore the options available for either a chef dinner experience or a villa cook experience and choose the one that suits you best. Each option offers a unique style and level of service. Further details and pricing can be found below. Once you have made your decision, please communicate the desired dates and frequency of these services to us via email.
- 3. If you prefer to cook your own meals, we offer a complimentary grocery stocking service prior to your arrival. You will only be charged for the cost of the groceries, and we will provide original receipts for transparency. This service ensures that you have all the necessary ingredients conveniently available, allowing you the freedom to prepare meals according to your preferences. Utilizing this service will help you avoid unnecessary stress and ensure a satisfying experience.
- 4. While there are several small grocery stores nearby, it's important to note that their selection can be limited and dependent on boat arrivals. However, you can generally find staple items readily available. Our knowledgeable staff is always ready to assist you in locating specific items, ensuring you have a smooth and convenient shopping experience.
- 5. Visitors to the Bahamas can bring up to \$100 worth of goods per person (excluding produce). Freezing meat items in a checked cooler saves costs due to limited options. When traveling as a family, inform customs about collective items in the cooler. Bringing snacks is recommended due to high prices in the Bahamas.
- 6. Please advise us of any food allergies or special food requirements e.g., gluten free due to health concerns in writing so we may share this with our staff, cooks, and chefs.

PREPARED MEALS - HOW DOES IT WORK?

*Typically, our staff may have their own unique way of doing things, adding to the Bahamian charm. Please make sure the kitchen is clean and prepared for their arrival.

- 1. On the day, the cook or chef will complete all necessary preparation for your meals. "Zemi" is the villa cook and available for all meals. "K'Lee" is the chef and available for evening dinners only.
- 2. You will be responsible for selecting your own beverages, wines etc. as this is a personal choice. House wines are available at cost.
- 3. The meals are either prepared entirely at the villa or partially off premise to conserve time on site. All timing and freshness sensitive preparation will be done at the villa.
- 4. The dinners will consist of a starter/appetizer, a main entree' and a dessert. Breakfast and lunches will be as requested.
- 5. The table will be set and when the meals are ready they will be served either family style by the cook or individually plated by the chef.
- 6. While you are eating, the staff will clean the kitchen and wash up all pans, utensils, etc. that they have used in the meal preparation. Once dessert is finished the staff will clean up dinnerware, cutlery, glasses and depart.

WHICH OPTION FOR ME?

Guests choose villas as a preferred vacation option for a variety of reasons. Some love the process of cooking for themselves while others enjoy having meals prepared some or all the time. This is what makes villa vacations unique...it can be how you want it to be.

We offer two options for having meals prepared for you. When ordering, there will be a selection for all guests together, as individual preferences cannot be accommodated due to limited staff and facilities. However, exceptions can be made for children and infants.

Option One: Chef K'Lee offers meals from the "Andros Night Delights Menu." As a qualified and accredited chef with extensive experience and positive guest reviews, K'Lee provides exceptional culinary expertise. You have the option to choose from a fixed menu or customize your meals. Ordering in advance from K'Lee's menu is a convenient and cost-effective solution. Anticipate a delightful multi-course meal comprising appetizers, a fish or meat entree, and dessert. The ingredients will be selected based on fresh availability, as Bahamian cuisine emphasizes the catch of the day. K'Lee will make efforts to accommodate specific favorite dishes not listed on the menu. Please refer to the separate attachment, "Andros Night Delights," for the current menu and pricing details.

Option Two: Zemi is the cook at KettleStone Villa and offers meals selected from the "Villa Kitchen Menu." Although not formally culinary accredited, Zemi possesses extensive villa and resort training, ensuring excellent and delicious meals. Many repeat guests entrust Zemi with all their dining needs.

Here's how it works: You can hire Zemi to prepare breakfasts, lunches, and dinners, or any combination you prefer. Zemi's services encompass shopping, preparation, cooking, family-style presentation, and clean-up. Please note that the rates mentioned do not include the cost of ingredients, which is your responsibility. The cook will provide receipts for all purchased items. Some pantry items like seasonings, oils, and sauces are available and will be charged at a nominal cost to avoid unnecessary purchases.

You have the option to allow the cook to plan the meal selection based on local island knowledge and fresh availability, or you can choose your meals in advance from the provided sample menus. Zemi is also accommodating of special requests if communicated in advance.

The villa recommendation is to simply indicate menu items you DO NOT prefer and let Zemi plan your meals completely.

WHAT CAN I EXPECT IN FOOD COSTS?

This is a very common question that we get asked. Although subject to many variables, we will try to give you a general idea. All estimates exclude beverages.

Local restaurants provide breakfasts and lunches for around \$15-\$20 each and casual dinners usually run around \$30 - \$45 with appetizers and dessert. Most restaurants offer local Bahamian fare and although they provide a local casual atmosphere with good food...they would not be described as "fine dining". One would argue however that some of the fish and conch dishes are very fine! (It doesn't hurt that they are right on the ocean either).

Grocery shopping in general is about 2.5 x the cost of items compared to North America prices on average. This is since everything comes by boat or plane and incurs higher freight costs as well as duty imposed on the import.

Typically, the cost of groceries will only average about \$45-\$55 per adult per day for 3 meals. Some guests have managed to average closer to \$40 while others have been closer to \$60. Obviously, the amount depends on your personal preferences and menu planning.

HOW DO I PAY?

Regardless of whether you choose to purchase groceries and do your own cooking or whether you decide to use a cook or a chef we make it simple for you to reconcile.

KettleStone will purchase all necessary items on your behalf and the chef and cook will provide KettleStone with their invoices which we will pay to them in local currency. You will be given an itemized bill prior to checkout which you can peruse and reconcile before departure.

Cash is always the preferred method of payment, however, if you wish to pay via PayPal or bank transfer this is perfectly acceptable. PayPal amounts should be sent as "friends and family" due to new changes with PayPal.

As these charges are for third party services.... If you wish to pay by credit card, payments can be facilitated though a local resort, however, we must add their 5% processing fee to the total.

GRATUITIES

Gratuities are appreciated by our chef and cook but are not automatically added on. This is at your total discretion. There is no bank on the island, so we recommend considering cash for this.

If you do wish to provide a gratuity, we ask you to do so directly to the cook or chef. We find this to be a more transparent and personable method.

KettleStone can reconcile gratuities on your behalf, but we ask you to provide written instructions as to the amount and how you wish it dispersed. Again, this makes for a more transparent and personable experience.

Each bedroom is appointed with Roman Travertine and Brazilian granite with contemporary European fixtures.

All bedrooms have their own high-capacity air conditioning unit for convenience.

"Morgan's Loft" is a luxurious open-loft master bedroom accessed via a hand-cut radial stone staircase, illuminated by natural light during the day and tastefully lit in the evenings. Situated 12 feet above the main villa, it offers privacy and a balcony with a charming Dutch door, showcasing stunning ocean and pool views. The space shares a 32-foot high glass cupola with the main villa, flooding the loft with sunlight and providing optional ventilation. KettleStone Villa Rental Terms and Conditions

Minimum Stay Requirements

Typical minimum stay requirements are 6 nights in Special Holiday Periods and 5 nights for Non-Holiday periods.

Damage Deposits

Damage Deposit for KettleStone villa is \$1,000.00 USD per rental. This will not be assessed if no damage occurs during your stay. If partial damage does occur (a broken lamp, a remote control tossed in the pool, etc.), we will assess an appropriate amount. If no damage occurs, your Damage Deposit will be refunded immediately after you return home. If you have paid by credit card, we will charge damage against your credit card only if necessary and we will advise you in advance.

Holiday Rate

- A 50% deposit confirms a reservation.
- Balance is due 90 days before travel.
- Cancellations >60 days receive a full refund.
- Cancellations <60 days incur a 100% cancellation fee.

Standard Rate

- A 50% deposit confirms a reservation.
- Balance is due 90 days before travel.
- Cancellations >60 days receive a full refund.
- Cancellations <60 days incur a 100% cancellation fee

<u>Cancellation Provision for Health-Related Restriction Issues</u>

If you are legally prevented from travelling to Andros Island, The Bahamas due to the following reasons, you will have the option of applying your cancellation fee to a future stay (subject to availability)

- Travel not permitted by the governing authorities for your region.
- Travel not permitted to Andros Island by the country of The Bahamas

Proof of these conditions being applicable to your reservation may be required as a condition of rebooking.

Arrival and Departure Times:

On the first day of your rental, the villa will be ready for you at 4pm. The villa departure time is 11am. If no other guests are scheduled to occupy your villa on arrival and departure days, you are welcome to check in early and check out as late as you wish. Ask us to advise you of the occupancy schedule of your villa. You may wish to check with us close to your arrival to determine flexibility.

You will be given 1 set of keys and one set of necessary remotes upon arrival. Please keep them well guarded and return them to our owner prior to departure. Any loss will be charged replacement cost only of \$25/ key and \$65/remote.

On departure day please be ready to meet with the villa representative for a departure inspection 1 hour prior to your departure. Departure time is 11am to allow cleaning staff to fully prepare the villa for new incoming guests arriving at 4pm.

Email Address and Telephone:

It is vital that we have a valid email address. We correspond via email. Once your booking has been made and your deposit received, all further correspondence is by email.

You will also require a cell phone so there may be mutual contact with you during your stay, this is for your convenience and safety.

Villa Rental Housekeeping Includes:

For bookings of 5 days or greater, one bedding change is provided mid-week and one additional bedding set will also be provided in each suite. For bookings of 5 days or less, a spare bedding set will be provided in each suite.

4 hours of mandatory light housekeeping is required daily and is included in the villa price. This does NOT include personal laundry services. Additional cleaning may be booked by arrangement for heavier cleaning, laundry, ironing and help with lunches and breakfasts etc. This is charged at a rate of \$15 per hour. Experience has shown us these 4 hours per day of contracted cleaning increases your villa enjoyment significantly (depending on the size of your group you may want to consider more hours or treat yourself).

Additional bedding changes other than described above can be arranged at a cost of \$20/single bed or \$30/queen/king bed.

For privacy purposes only, we can move the mandatory 4 hours daily housekeeping service until the departure day with agreement. This can be arranged prior to arrival or any time throughout your stay. However, this will mean that our task of cleaning the villa on a single day will be much more difficult and time-consuming. Extra staff will be required and a fee of \$300 will be charged.

<u>Utility Usage and the Environment:</u>

Our home is your home while you are here on vacation. To keep our rental rates as low as possible, we ask you to think carefully and be thoughtful about the usage of both water and electricity. Unfortunately, as the price of island paradise... all our energy costs are four times your average domestic costs due to fuel surcharges. This creates a heightened environmental and financial sensitivity to wasting resources.

Unfortunately, some guests tend to be less sensitive and therefore are poor at conservation. For example, air conditioning should never be left on in rooms being unoccupied as it only takes 30 minutes to cool a room. Again, AC should never be switched on in rooms with either doors or windows open, this not only defeats the purpose of putting on the air conditioning but can also lead to premature failure of the air conditioning units as they will be over-working trying to cool a room to a desired temperature that it will never be able to reach. Fans should also be switched off when the room is not being used, as should lights and other electrical items.
